

**AirUWS-Lite is the University's primary wireless network. This fact sheet describes connecting to AirUWS-Lite using an iPhone.**

Please note that iPhones cannot connect to the older network, AirUWS, which continues to operate. It has been assumed that readers will be familiar with operating their iPhone.

## Connecting

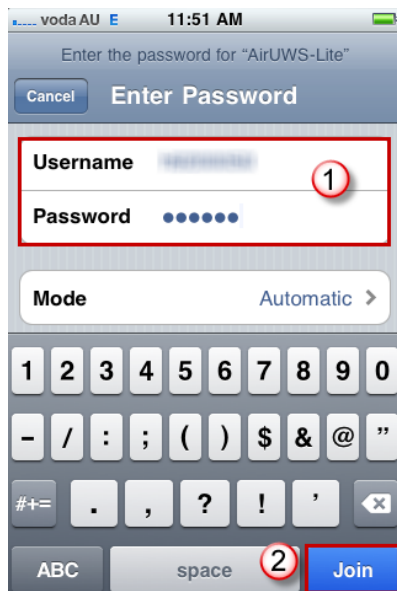


Tap the **Settings** icon on your iPhone's home screen.

When the **Settings** menu opens, tap **Wi-Fi**.



Ensure Wi-Fi is turned **ON** (1). Your iPhone will search for local wireless networks. Tap **AirUWS-Lite** (2) when it is found. Do not try to connect to AirUWS.



You will be prompted for your username and password. Enter your **MyUWSAccount** credentials (1) and tap **Join** (2).



A certificate screen similar to this example will appear. Tap **Accept**.



If you make a mistake entering your MyUWSAccount credentials, you'll see an error message. Tap **Dismiss** and enter your correct credentials.

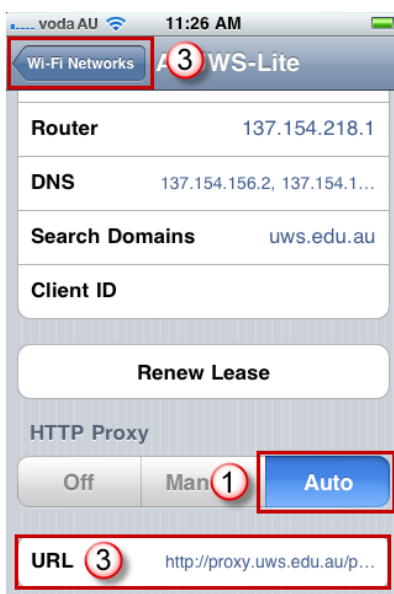
When your credentials have been accepted, a tick appears next to AirUWS-Lite. A blue wireless icon is shown at the top of the screen.

You are now connected to AirUWS-Lite, but haven't finished yet!



### Configure your proxy settings

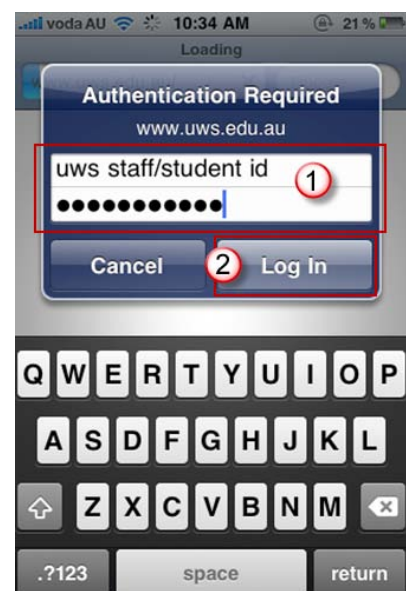
Although connected to the network, you'll need to enter the UWS proxy settings to use the Internet.



Tap the blue arrow next to AirUWS-Lite to access the network's settings. Scroll to the bottom, tap **Auto** (1), and enter the following address in the URL field: <http://proxy.uws.edu.au/proxy.pac> (2). Tap **Wi-Fi Networks** (3) to save the settings. Return to your home screen.

### Use the web

Launch Safari. When prompted, enter your **MyUWSAccount credentials** (1). Tap **Log In** (2) to access the Internet.



### Disconnecting

You will be automatically disconnected if you leave the coverage area. Alternatively, open **Settings**, tap **Wi-Fi** and then **AirUWS-Lite's blue arrow**. Tap **Forget this Network** and tap **Forget** (this is the most secure method of disconnecting).

### Future logins

If you disconnect by leaving the coverage area, you should only need to open **Settings** → **Wi-Fi Networks** and tap **AirUWS-Lite** to reconnect. If you "forgot the network" to disconnect, you may find you need to restart the connection process to login.
