The first year includes a pre-requisite introductory unit which is worth 20 credit points (UWS units are usually 10 credit points) studied in the summer session. Therefore, annual fees are set out as follow: 1st year \$24,500 [2010: 1st year \$25,250]; 2nd year \$17,150 [2010: 2nd year \$17,675 based on 2010 approved fee]. Total estimate 2009 course fee: \$41,650 [2010: \$42,925 based on 2010 approved fee]. Note: All students will need to successfully complete the pre-requisite introductory unit called 'Introduction to Nursing' before being allowed to continue their study in the B Nursing (Graduate Entry).
