A Mid-Year Prize Ceremony (evening) is held to recognize the academic excellence of graduates from the Nursing and Midwifery School and Science and Health School as well as School of Medicine MBBS Years 1, 2 and 3 students. Dean's Medal recipients from each school are also awarded at this Ceremony.
