The tuition fees quoted above are the fees for the normal full-time study load of the course (80 credit points per annum) in the year specified unless otherwise indicated. International students will be subject to a variable fee regime; i.e. be required to pay fees during their course based on the approved fee for each calendar year. Fee changes (if any) will occur at 1 January each calendar year. This applies to all courses except the MBA, and GDBA. The estimated total course fee given in offer letters will include the estimated tuition fees (based on the above information) and estimated student association fees for the duration of the course. Students who extend their course past the normal finish date of the course, either by repeating subjects through failures or by taking extra subjects, will be required to pay additional fees to be determined at the time, based on the prevailing fee levels.

♦ This program has a duration of 6 months or less (full-time), therefore International students are required to contact DIAC for visa advice and eligibility prior to applying. www.diac.gov.au

▲ The B Nursing (Graduate Entry) 4643 requires completion of 170 credit points ie. 1st year 100 credit points; 2nd year 70 credit points. The first year includes a pre-requisite introductory unit which is worth 20 credit points (UWS units are usually 10 credit points) studied in the summer session. Therefore, annual fees are set out as follow: 1st year \$24,500 [2010: 1st year \$25,250]; 2nd year \$17,150 [2010: 2nd year \$17,675 based on 2010 approved fee]. Total estimate 2009 course fee: \$41,650 [2010: \$42,925 based on 2010 approved fee]. Note: All students will need to successfully complete the pre-requisite introductory unit called 'Introduction to Nursing' before being allowed to continue their study in the B Nursing (Graduate Entry). This unit has been organised to enable student feedback from week one (1). Students will be alerted in week three (3) of study if they are at risk of not passing the unit. If students do not pass the pre-requisite introductory unit, they will automatically be made an offer into the standard three (3) year B Nursing program (code 4642) for the February 2009 intake. Alternatively, students may nominate another UWS course for which they would like to be assessed. A special orientation program for B Nursing (Graduate Entry) students will start on Friday, 9 January 2010

+The requirements for International students for admission to be considered for M Creative Music Therapy:

- International candidates must have a recognised relevant overseas Bachelor's degree or equivalent and need to understand English to a high level - IELTS score (6.5)
- International applicants who are unable to attend the audition are required to submit a DVD and a written essay. For details please contact the course advisor, Dr Alan Lem
- All candidates must have a high degree of practical musicianship, to be demonstrated during the interview/audition process. For further information, contact the course advisor, Dr Alan Lem.

**Please note that M Social Science offers a specialist pool of units in Child and Youth Studies as 'external study' units. International students with student visas in Australia are not permitted to enrol in more than a quarter of their programs in external units and in each compulsory study session must enrol in at least one internal unit. As a consequence, student visa holder cannot choose all the Child and Youth Studies units.

*** This program can also be completed in 12 months accelerated mode.

▲ Students can complete the program in accelerated mode in 18 months, or may select to complete it full-time over 2 years. Depending on the M Teaching program enrolled in, students can exit with the relevant M Teaching (Primary) 1608 and M Teaching (Secondary) 1609.

■ Application deadlines for M Teaching (Primary) 1608 and M Teaching (Secondary) 1609 are: 30 May 2009 (for 2009 July intake) and 30 November 2009 (for Feb intake 2010)
